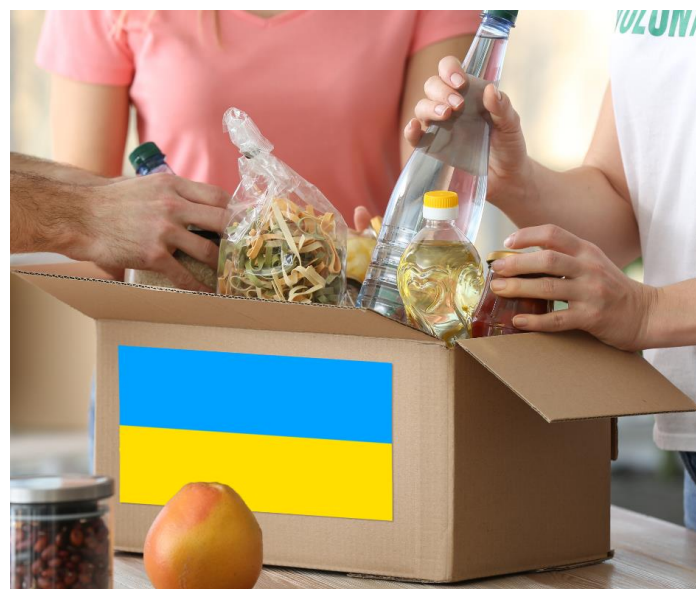

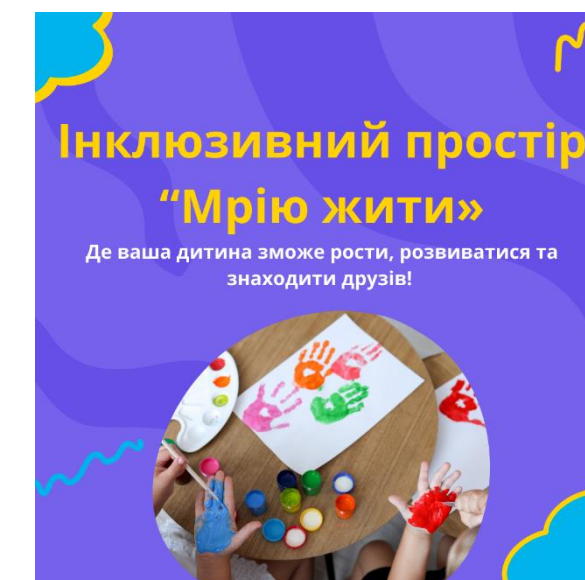

The Foundation has set a goal within the project to provide as many Ukrainian children with disabilities as possible with everything they need to study. After all, despite the war, life goes on, and children need to acquire knowledge in order to benefit the country and the world with their work, creativity, and skills in the future.

The “Dream to Live” Foundation purchased 120 school backpacks with school supplies for children with disabilities in Kyiv and Kyiv region, thus providing them with everything they need for school.

The Mama Special project is a social initiative launched in Ukraine in 2021 by the I Dream to Live charity foundation to support and reward heroic mothers raising children with disabilities.

The Mama Special project was held as part of a comprehensive barrier-free program implemented at the Neopolis amusement park to improve the accessibility of the location. The barrier-free program involves the adaptation of the Neopolis space and recommendations for using attractions for children with different needs and their parents, as well as the relevant competencies of the park's staff.

The main objective of the program is to offer safe leisure activities and adapt a place where families can spend time together, receiving positive emotions and impressions.

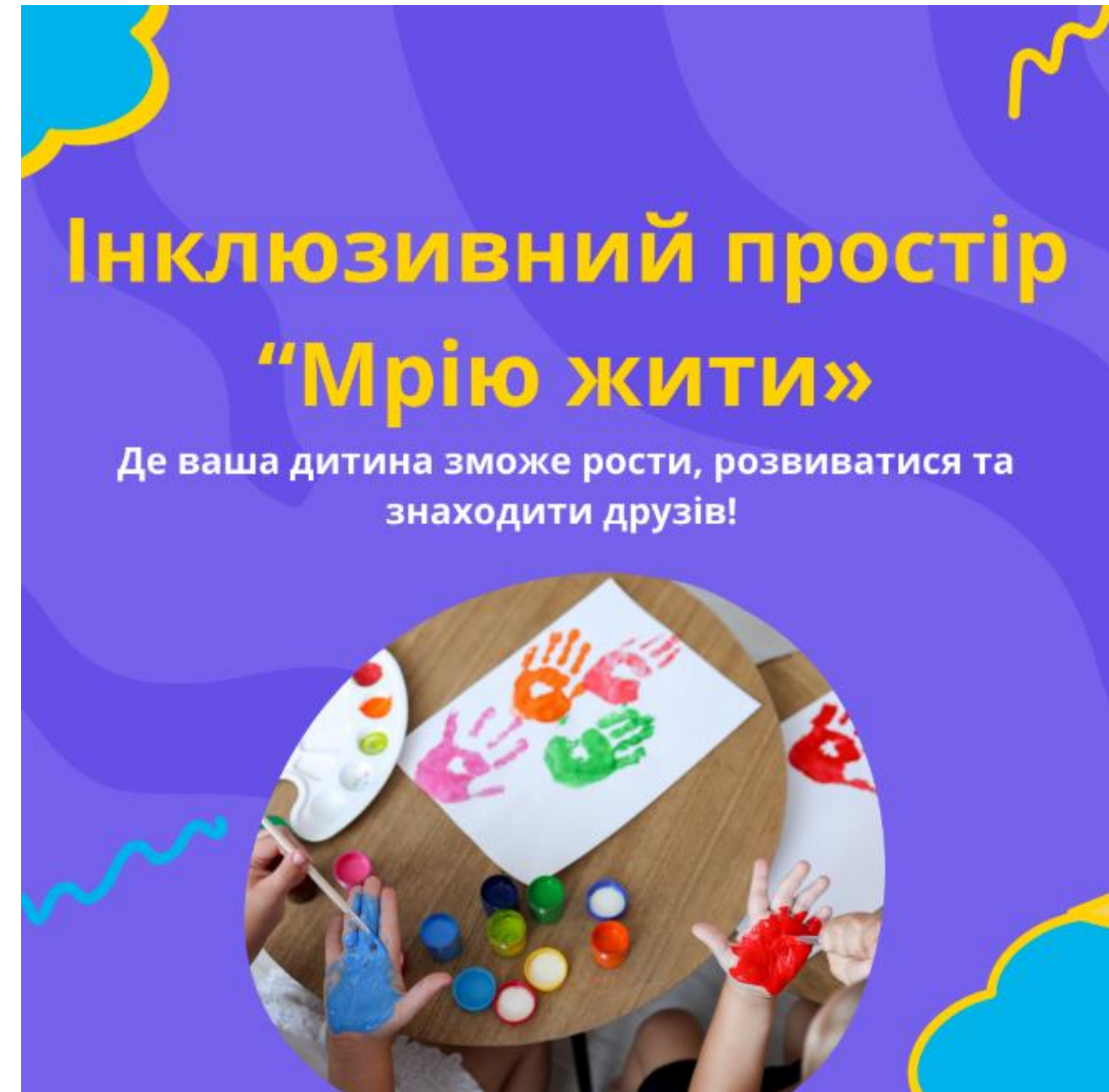
Areas of activity of the Inclusive Space:

- Neurosensory integration - modern techniques to improve cognitive and physical functions.

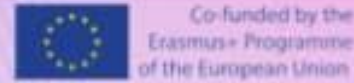

We are grateful to the organizers for the opportunity to join this event and develop international cooperation to improve rehabilitation programs in Ukraine.



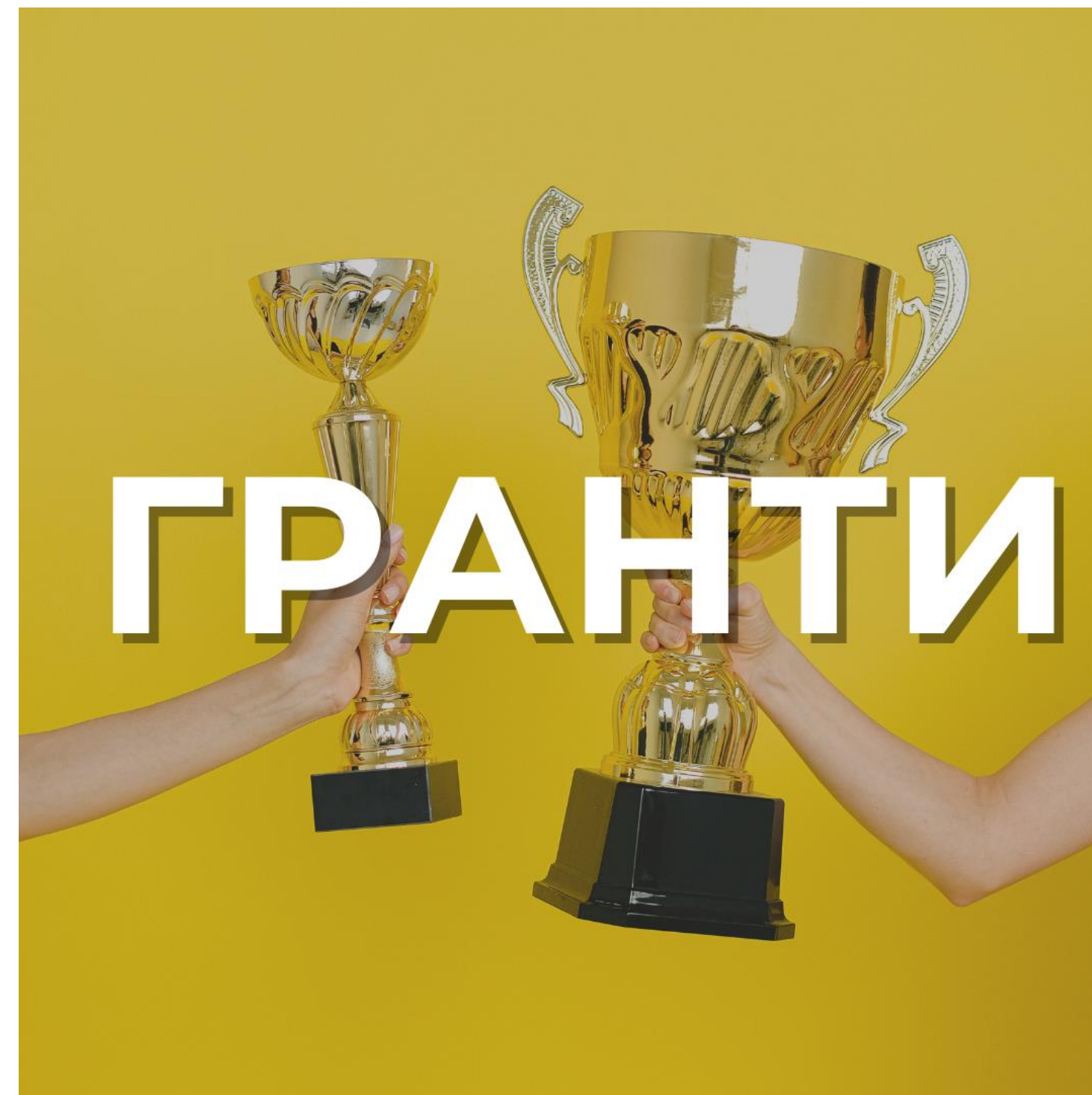
Grants
