The Dream to Live Charitable Foundation has been working for 12 years to support children with disabilities (cerebral palsy/autism spectrum disorder) and their families.

Our mission is to create conditions for improving the quality of life of children with special needs, their development, socialization, and integration into society.

In 2024, despite all the challenges, our foundation continued its activities aimed at providing necessary assistance to the most vulnerable segments of the population. We focused on the following key areas:

- Providing support to families by paying for rehabilitation services for children in specialized centers.
- Creating an inclusive space where children can receive help, develop, and make friends.
- Organizing events that promote the socialization of children and support their families.

In addition, we continued to support the Armed Forces of Ukraine by providing humanitarian aid, resources, and equipment, understanding the importance of everyone's contribution to the nationwide effort.

Our team is working tirelessly to make this world a better place for children who need attention, warmth, and support. We are grateful to every patron, partner, and donor for helping us implement our initiatives.

Day care for children with disabilities

The Dream to Live Charitable Foundation, based at the World of Opportunities inclusive center, is implementing a project providing day care for children with disabilities in subgroup A thanks to financial support in the form of small grants for the provision of social services. It is a safe and caring space where children aged 3 to 10 receive support, development, and the opportunity to be with their peers. We care for special children who need constant supervision throughout the day.

What we offer:

- all-day stay for the child in an inclusive environment;
- socialization and a friendly circle of communication;
- games, creative activities, and development of independence skills;
- individual attention and support for each child.

The project is implemented with the support of the UK Government as part of the SPIRIT program, in cooperation with the Ministry of Social Policy of Ukraine, the Social Protection Fund for Persons with Disabilities, and UNICEF Ukraine, administered by ISAR Unity. 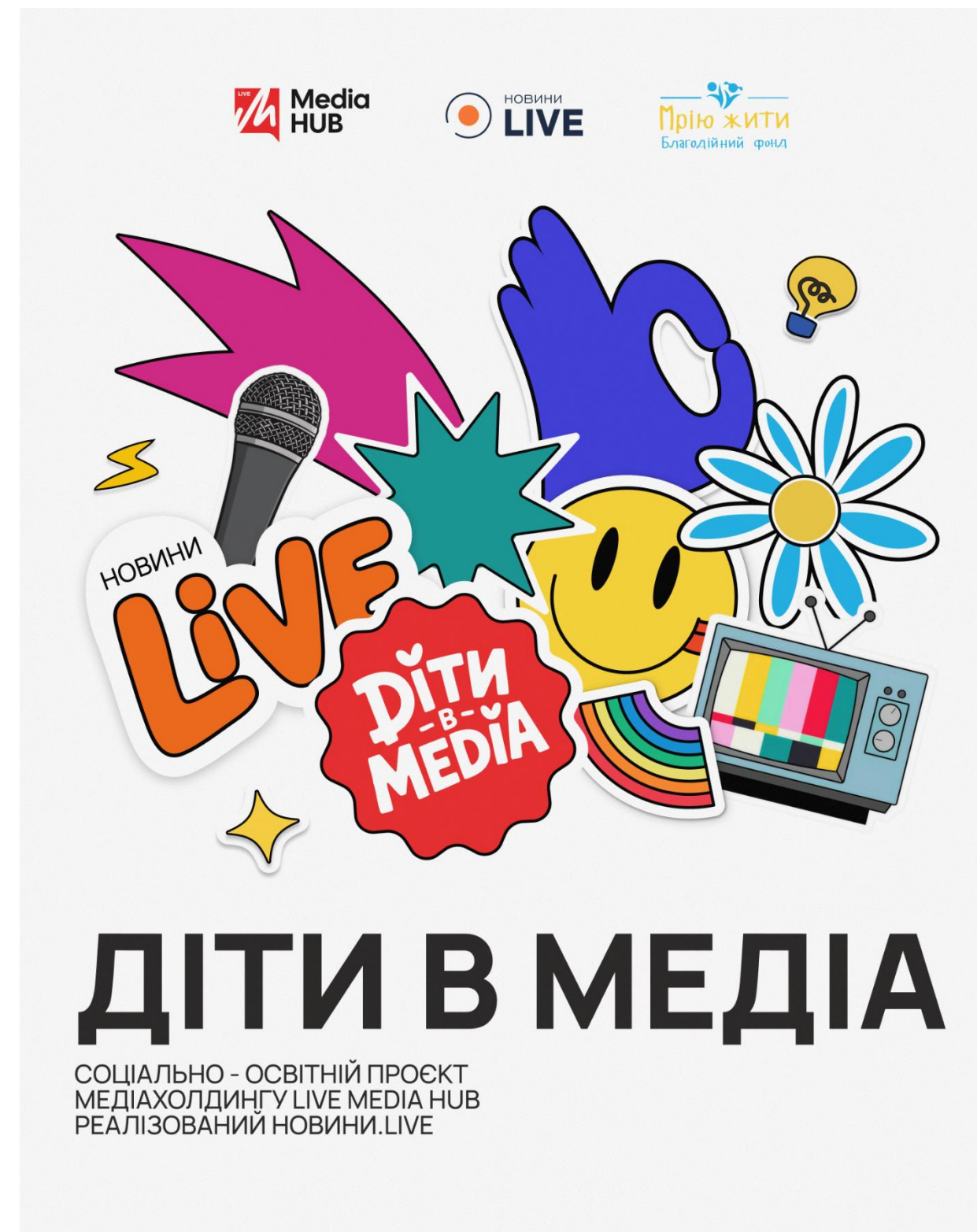

Charity campaign “Give a child joy”

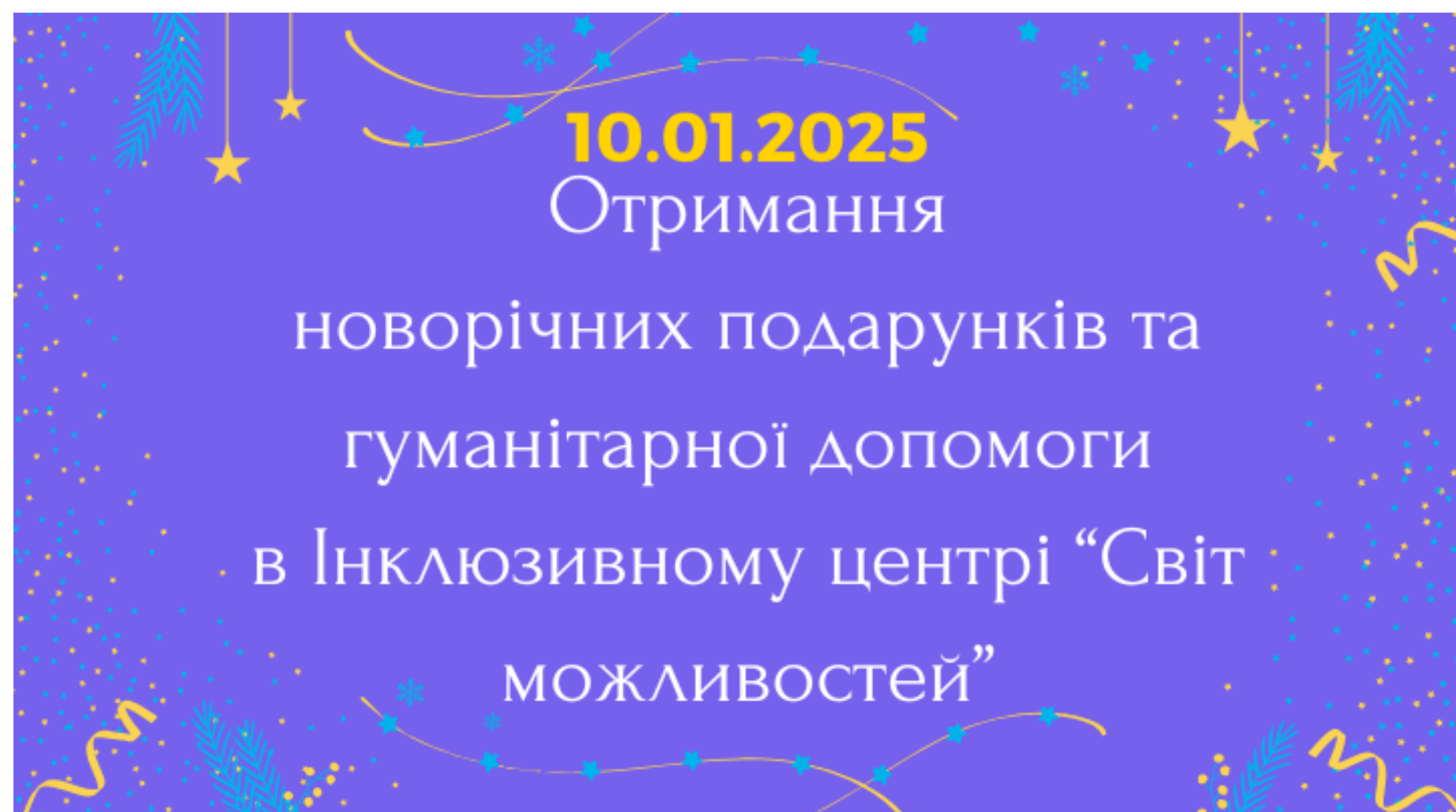
The charity fund “Dream to Live” together with Primary School No. 332 has started a good cause!

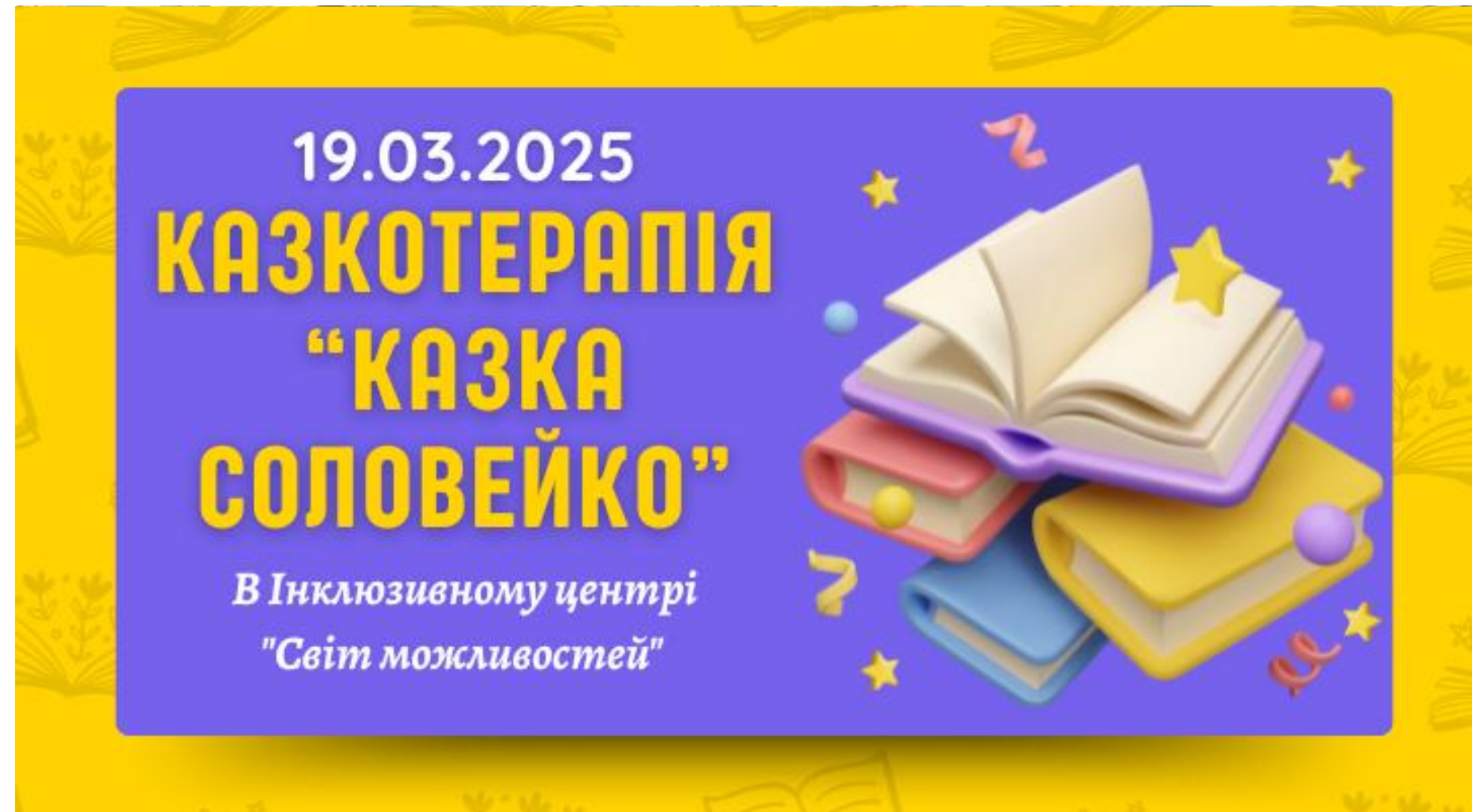

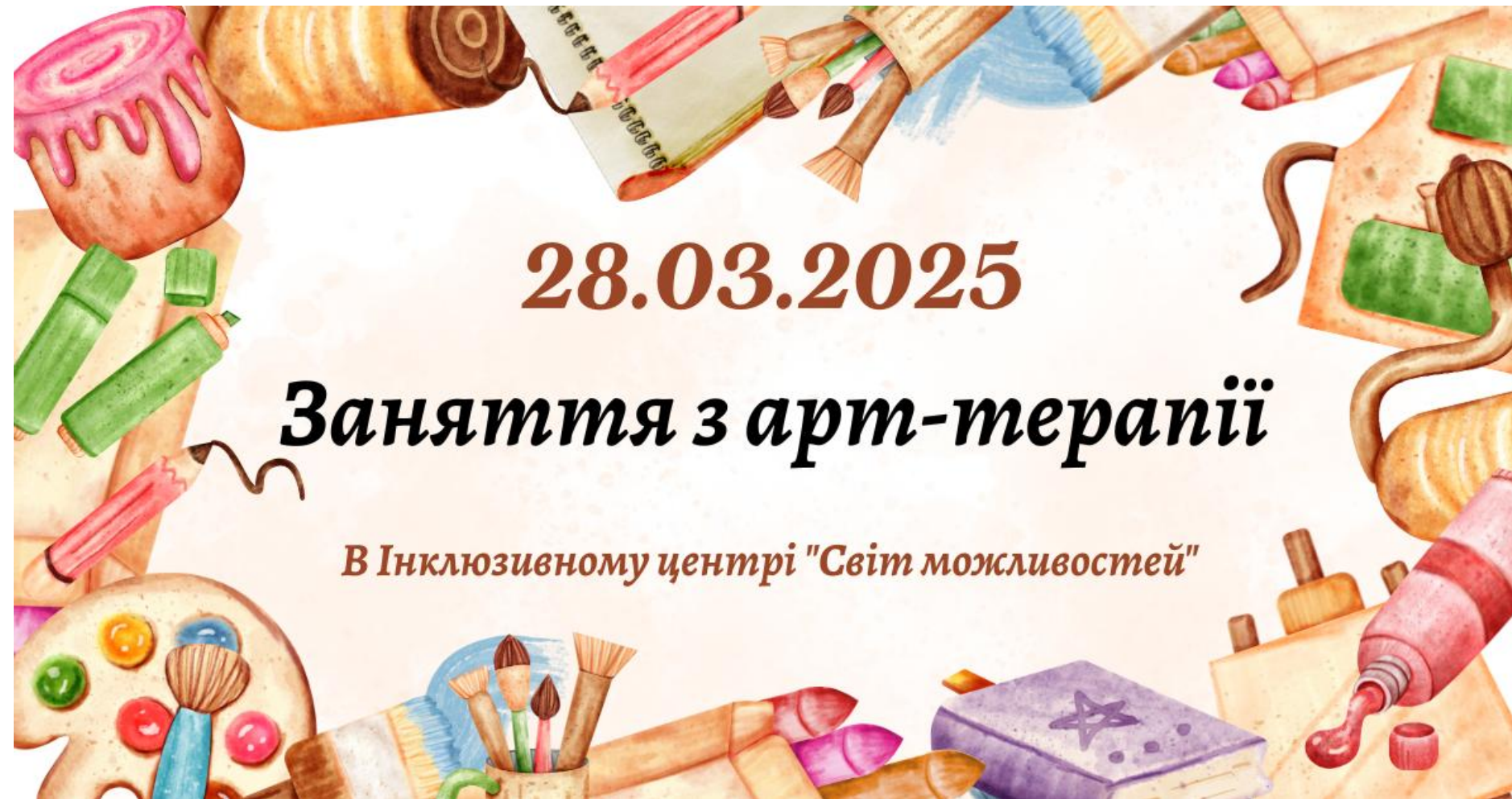

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Floristry master class

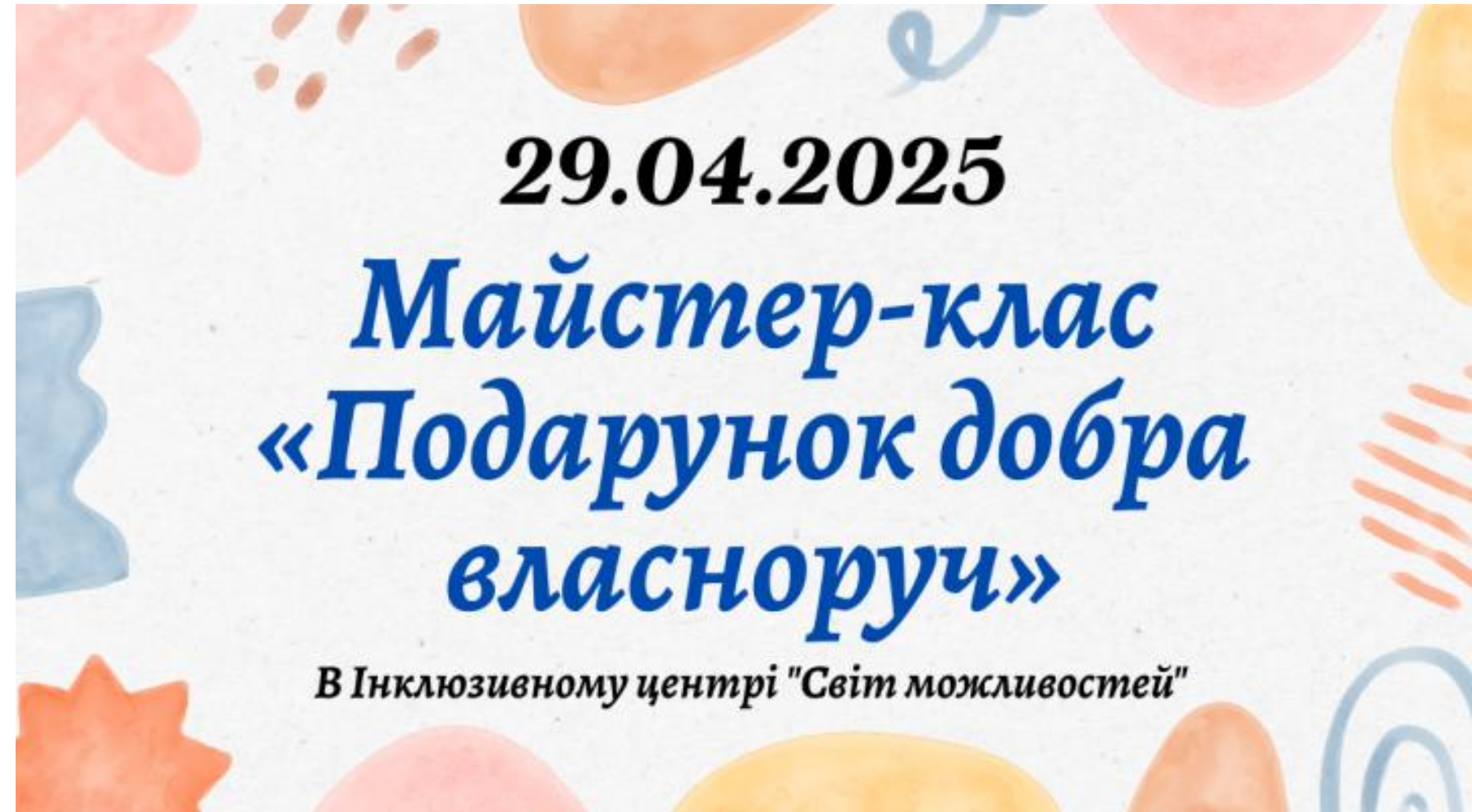

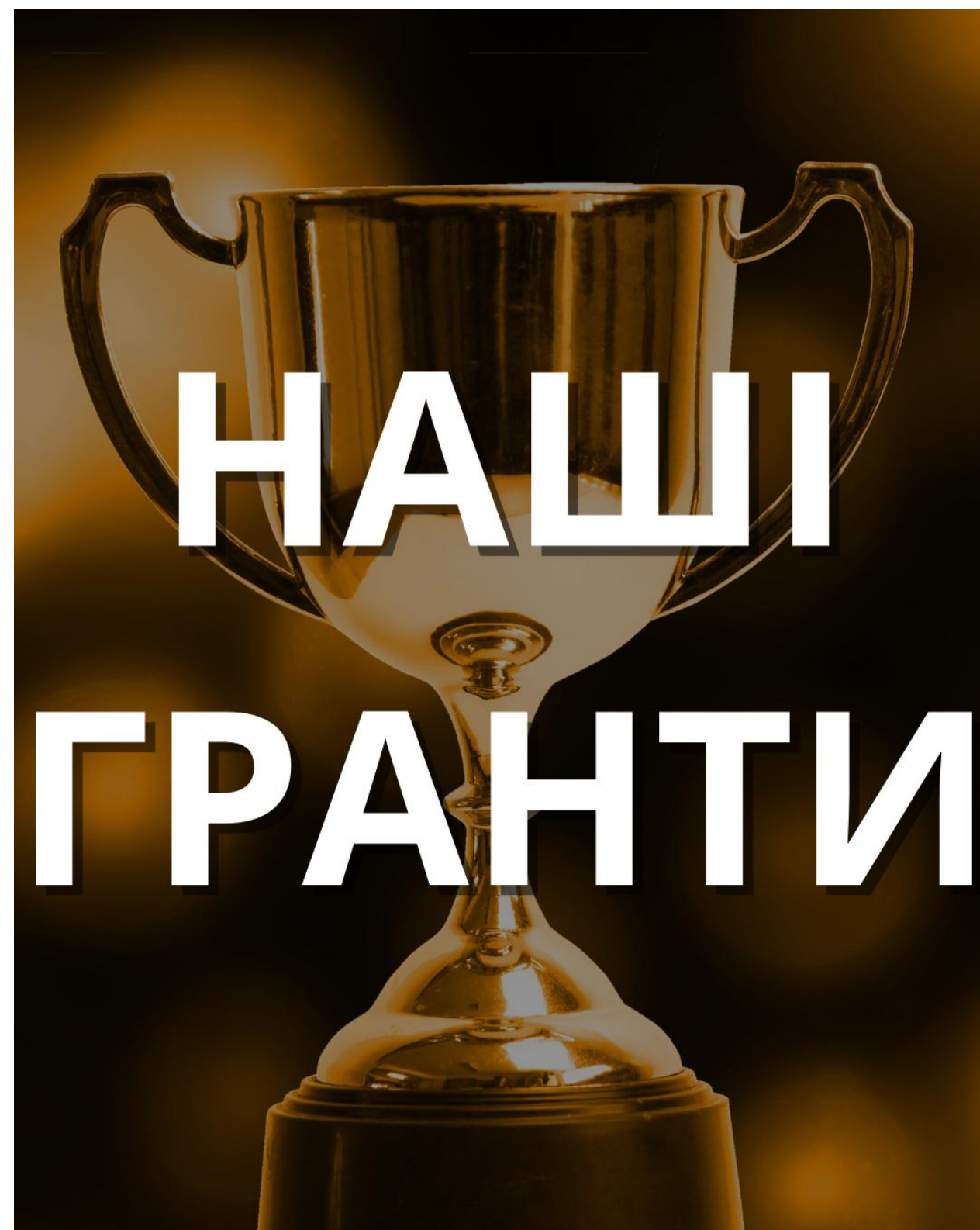
Grants
